The Council has today launched a Consultation Exercise on the Historic Environment Supplementary Planning Document Consultation Draft. The SPD is an update of existing heritage advice with changes made across the whole document to bring it in line with the latest guidance and government policy, with an increased emphasis on due regard to the heritage significance of assets and the consideration of harm. In revising the document, the aim is that the SPD will be to support the heritage policies SC16-SC21 of the Local Plan for Bolsover District.

The Consultation runs from Monday 23rd February to Monday 23rd March 2025.
